The following information was requested on 2 October and clarified on 15 October 2024:

[You requested on 2 October 2024]:

I am writing to request a copy of your 'Never Events' report data please.

I am ideally looking for the data to be provided in an Excel format, covering the following points:

- *Number of recorded Never Events by month and per Trust for the last 10 years*
 - *Breakdown of the Never Events by description (total of each), per Trust for the last 10 years*
 - *The total value of claims paid out in relation to Never Events, per Trust, per year for the last 10 years*
- The value of claims paid out in relation to Never Events - by Never Event Description – per Trust, for the last 10 years*

[We sought clarified on 15 October 2024]:

I wanted to advise that NHS Resolution doesn't hold information about all Never Events, but rather only those that resulted in claims.

NHS England lists all the Never Events on their website: ([2018-Never-Events-List-updated-February-2021.pdf \(england.nhs.uk\)](#)). Of this list, we could provide the following Events that we have a learning code for:

- *Wrong site surgery*
- *Retained foreign object post procedure*
- *Mis-selection of a strong potassium solution*
- *Failure to install functional collapsible shower or curtain rails*
- *Misplaced naso- or oro-gastric tubes*

Our Response

Please find attached the requested information we are able to provide. Our Claims data only covers England and not the rest of the UK.

We are only able to provide data under specific codes that we capture within our claims management system. Please see here for the clinical codes: [CNST-Codes.xlsx](#) . This system is primarily designed to manage claims and therefore will not capture every type of potential cause or event. We have identified the cause codes that may contain instances of never events. We do not capture in our claims management system never events as a cause. Therefore, the data presented will contain claims that are **not** never events as per the criteria. We are unable to identify from the data provided which claims do and do not feature never events but have selected the cause codes which are most likely to feature a never event.

There may be other claims within our system that feature never events but are captured under a different cause code. We are unable to search the individual cases as to do so would exceed the FOI limit. Therefore, we estimate that the cost of complying with the request in its entirety would exceed the 'appropriate limit'. Section 12(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 is a provision which allows a public authority to refuse to comply with a request for information where the cost of compliance is estimated to exceed a set limit (known as the 'appropriate limit'). The 'appropriate limit' for NHS Resolution is £450. This equates to 18 hours of work at the rate of £25 per hour set out in the 'Fees Regulations'. We have provided the information we are able to provide within the cost limit.

As advised, we only hold data where the Never Event resulted in a claim for compensation. [NHS England](#) may hold other data relating to Never Events.

Please note: We have recently changed the way we report on our FOIs to align better with our published documents. Streamlining our reporting on FOIs with our annual published reports may mean a variation in snapshot dates. This means this data may not align with previous similar requests and it may not be possible for you to compare this information with a previous request. Claims notified/received in any given year will often relate to incidents that have occurred many years prior. Due to the nature of clinical negligence claims and the level of investigation needed to bring them to a resolution, claims received and notified in a specific year may take years to settle and close. They are not guaranteed to be settled and closed in the same year. As such, there will be a time gap between incident and claim closure.

Due to the way in which data is extracted, it is also possible that the same claim may appear more than once in a dataset, across different year groups e.g. where the case has been closed (as nil damages payment), challenged, reopened, and closed again at conclusion.

The data shows variation in numbers of cases received, closed per year, and costs attributed to those claims. This is a reflection of the nature of individual claims received and resolved by NHS Resolution which can vary significantly. As such these fluctuations cannot be interpreted as trends.

The longer version of some of the causes are:

NotDet = not detected

IntravAdminMisselecConcentrPotassChlor = Intravenous administration of mis selected concentration of Potassium Chloride

InPatientSuicide- NonCollapsible Rails = In patient suicide - non-collapsible rails not installed.

Please note: the tables broken down by Trusts should not be interpreted as a league table. Larger member organisations and those which provide more complex treatments may receive more claims than smaller organisations or those providing low risk care. Inevitably, different institutions face different levels of risk because of the variations in the nature and complexity of the procedures they perform. In some circumstances, volumes of reported cases may be impacted by multiple claims notified in relation to one cause of action.

PPOs

The information disclosed includes damages and costs paid up to the end of the settlement year (in Periodical payment order (PPO) cases) and up to the end of the closure year in non-PPO cases.

PPOs are an agreement between the parties, to pay an initial lump sum and regular future payments (PPO damages) related to the injured party's ongoing needs, usually care for life i.e., a percentage of the full value of the claim is paid at the point of settlement (lump sum damages) with the balance paid at regular intervals over subsequent years. The information disclosed includes lump sum damages, costs and any PPO damages paid up to the end of the year of settlement. It does not include PPO damages, which have been committed to but due to be paid after the settlement year.

Low figures

We have not provided the information for low figures involved as we believe that disclosure of information with this level of granularity is exempt under Section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3A) (a) of the FOI Act, where disclosure to a member of the public would contravene one or more of the data protection principles. The data protection principles are set out in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation. We take the view that it would not be fair or lawful (given the sensitive and confidential nature of the information held) to disclose such information, and any disclosure would therefore contravene the first data protection principle.

In some instances, the low numbers of claims (fewer than 5) in each category, the likelihood exists that individuals who are the subject of this information may be identified either from this information alone, or in combination with other available information. In addition to this, as this information is considered to be sensitive personal data (the data subjects' medical condition); NHS Resolution believes it has a greater responsibility to

protect those individuals' identities, as disclosure could potentially cause damage and/or distress to those involved.

Further to our obligations to provide advice and assistance, you may find it helpful to review the work of the [Getting It Right First Time team](#) with whom NHS Resolution has been working with to undertake in-depth analysis of our claims data. They have produced several [reports](#) from analysing our claims data which has been shared following approval of the confidentiality advisory group to the use of confidential patient information for this purpose.
