I would like all the information you hold in its most granular form going back 10 years. I am particularly interested in claims related to anaesthesia, pain medicine/management, interventional radiology, intensive care (adult and paediatric).

For each of these areas it is important that all the information you hold is provided and not filtered.

I want to see dates of incidents, narratives of claims where available, details of the operations or procedures involved, any available details you can share about the patients affected, and most importantly the amounts paid in settlement.

Thank you for your prompt and helpful reply. Could you please provide me with the information described below - all separated out:

1. For the following specialties: Anaesthesia, Intensive Care Medicine, Spinal surgery, Neurosurgery, Pain Medicine, Interventional Radiology
2. Separated out by adult/child, and by Trust,
3. Number of claims received by Specialty code, the number of claims closed with nil damages paid; the number of claims closed with a damages payment and associated costs; a breakdown by injury code; a breakdown by cause
4. All settlement amounts. If not available, the upper decile of settlement amounts for each
5. Any narrative information about each claim, or links to further information if in the public domain.
6. Period - at least the past 10 years or 20 if possible.

I write further to your request for information. We will need clarification on your request.

We need clarification on the following:

For specialty we can provide anaesthesia, intensive care medicine, neurosurgery, and radiology. However, we **cannot** provide interventional radiology, spinal surgery, or pain medicine as these are **not** specialty codes on our claims database.

Are you interested in the specialty we can provide?

If so, we can provide a breakdown for each specialty by:

- Breakdown by Adult/Child. Do you want number of claims received, as well as numbers closed with a damages payment with the cost included, also a table for nil damages paid?
- Breakdown by Trust. Do you want number of claims received, as well as numbers closed with a damages payment with the cost included, also a table for nil damages paid?
- Breakdown by cause. Do you want number of claims received, as well as numbers closed with a damages payment with the cost included, also a table for nil damages paid?

- *Breakdown by injury. Do you want number of claims received, as well as numbers closed with a damages payment with the cost included, also a table for nil damages paid?*

We can provide the above for the last 10 financial years.

It is not clear what you mean by “5. Any narrative information about each claim.” We cannot provide information about individual claims, but we can provide the primary cause of the claim as described above. Are you interested in this information?

In terms of - 4. All settlement amounts. If not available, the upper decile of settlement amounts for each – We can provide the cost of closed claims (or those settled with a PPO payment) during the time period in question. This will be included in the above tables.

Happy New Year to you and thank you for your help.

Yes, please provide anaesthesia, intensive care medicine, neurosurgery, and radiology.

And a breakdown as you suggest, over the previous 10 years.

Please provide any information about primary cause of the claim if you have any.

Our Response

Please find attached the requested information we are able to provide. We only hold claims data for England, not the rest of the UK.

Please note: We have recently changed the way we report on our FOIs to align better with our published documents. Streamlining our reporting on FOIs with our annual published reports may mean a variation in snapshot dates. This means this data may not align with previous similar requests and it may not be possible for you to compare this information with a previous request. For further information, please refer to

Claims notified/received in any given year will often relate to incidents that have occurred many years prior. Due to the nature of clinical negligence claims and the level of investigation needed to bring them to a resolution, claims received and notified in a specific year may take years to settle and close. They are not guaranteed to be settled and closed in the same year. As such, there will be a time gap between incident and claim closure.

Due to the way in which data is extracted, it is also possible that the same claim may appear more than once in a dataset, across different year groups e.g. where the case has been closed (as nil damages payment), challenged, reopened, and closed again at conclusion.

The data shows variation in numbers of cases received, closed per year and costs attributed to those claims. This is a reflection of the nature of individual claims received and resolved by NHS Resolution which can vary significantly. As such these fluctuations cannot be interpreted as trends.

Please note the tables should **not** be interpreted as a league table. Larger member organisations and those which provide more complex treatments may receive more claims than smaller organisations or those providing low risk care. Inevitably, different institutions face different levels of risk because of the variations in the nature and complexity of the procedures they perform. For example, a number of high value claims in a complex treatment environment may skew the average damages awards. In some circumstances, volumes of reported cases may be impacted by multiple claims notified in relation to one cause of action. The value of claims will depend on individual circumstances and the data may be impacted significantly by small numbers of high value claims.

PPOs

The information disclosed includes damages and costs paid up to the end of the settlement year (in Periodical payment order (PPO) cases) and up to the end of the closure year in non-PPO cases.

PPOs are an agreement between the parties, to pay an initial lump sum and regular future payments (PPO damages) related to the injured party's ongoing needs, usually care for life i.e., a percentage of the full value of the claim is paid at the point of settlement (lump sum damages) with the balance paid at regular intervals over subsequent years. The information disclosed includes lump sum damages, costs and any PPO damages paid up to the end of the year of settlement. It does not include PPO damages, which have been committed to but due to be paid after the settlement year.

Low figures

We have not provided the information for low figures involved as we believe that disclosure of information with this level of granularity is exempt under Section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3A) (a) of the FOI Act, where disclosure to a member of the public would contravene one or more of the data protection principles. The data protection principles are set out in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation. We take the view that it would not be fair or lawful (given the sensitive and confidential nature of the information held) to disclose such information, and any disclosure would therefore contravene the first data protection principle.

In some instances, the low numbers of claims (fewer than 5) in each category, the likelihood exists that individuals who are the subject of this information may be identified either from this information alone, or in combination with other available information. In addition to this, as this information is considered to be sensitive personal data (the data subjects' medical condition); NHS Resolution believes it has a greater responsibility to protect those individuals' identities, as disclosure could potentially cause damage and/or distress to those involved.

Further to our obligations to provide advice and assistance, you may find it helpful to review the work of the [Getting It Right First Time team](#) with whom NHS Resolution has been working with to undertake in-depth analysis of our claims data. They have produced several [reports](#) from analysing our claims data which has been shared following approval of the confidentiality advisory group to the use of confidential patient information for this purpose.
