The following information was requested on 7 December 2020:

*As you cannot provide the data requested, please may I request the below as mentioned as an alternative in your response?*

*Will this come in two separate data sets for obstetrics and paediatrics?*

*We could provide you with high level data relating to the specialty:*

- *Obstetrics (we cannot report on hypoglycaemia)*
- *Paediatrics (we cannot report on hypoglycaemia)*

*It could cover number of claims received for the above specialty in the relevant financial years (2009/10 – 2019/20); numbers settled and associated costs; a breakdown by primary injury; a breakdown by primary cause; numbers with no damages paid and numbers currently open.*

### **Our Response**

Please find attached the requested information. Please note the settled cases relate to settled in those years and therefore some will have been notified before 2009. The same applies to cases closed with nil damages paid.

We have suppressed low figures as we believe that disclosure of information with this level of granularity is exempt under Section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3)(a)(i) of the Act, where disclosure to a member of the public would contravene one or more of the data protection principles. The data protection principles are set out in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation. We take the view that it would not be fair or lawful (given the sensitive and confidential nature of the information held) to disclose such information, and any disclosure would therefore contravene the first data protection principle.

In some instances the low numbers of claims (fewer than 5) in each category, the likelihood exists that individuals who are the subject of this information may be identified either from this information alone, or in combination with other available information. In

addition to this, as this information is considered to be sensitive personal data (the data subjects' medical condition); NHS Resolution believes it has a greater responsibility to protect those individuals' identities, as disclosure could potentially cause damage and/or distress to those involved. Where we are in the territory of such small numbers in the attached, we have used a '#' symbol in the relevant field. You should still be able to see aggregate/total details for higher level fields containing this data.
