The following information was requested on 1 April 2021:

Thank you for your response to my FOI_4982 request and the resource links.

I would like to ask, in reference to the response, if I could please have access to the 'high level data' relating to 'The injury- Cancer' and 'The injury- Advanced Staged Cancer' for the financial years 2018/2019 and 2019/2020?

Our Response

Please find attached the requested information.

In terms of tables 4 and 5 - The data provided reflects the number of claims settled and paid in each financial year and not the number of claims received in that year by NHS Resolution. Due to the nature of clinical negligence claims and the level of investigation needed to bring them to a resolution, claims received and notified in a specific year may take years to settle.

We have suppressed low numbers as we believe that disclosure of information with this level of granularity is exempt under Section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3A)(i) of the FOI Act, where disclosure to a member of the public would contravene one or more of the data protection principles. The data protection principles are set out in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation. We take the view that it would not be fair or lawful (given the sensitive and confidential nature of the information held) to disclose such information, and any disclosure would therefore contravene the first data protection principle.

In some instances the low numbers of claims (fewer than 5) in each category, the likelihood exists that individuals who are the subject of this information may be identified either from this information alone, or in combination with other available information. In addition to this, as this information is considered to be sensitive personal data (the data subjects' medical condition); NHS Resolution believes it has a greater responsibility to

protect those individuals identities', as disclosure could potentially cause damage and/or distress to those involved. Where we are in the territory of such small numbers in the attached, we have used a '#' symbol in the relevant field. You should still be able to see aggregate/total details for higher level fields containing this data.
